

SUMMARY OF THE 11TH INTERDISCIPLINARY INTERNATIONAL CONFERENCE (2026)

The 11th International Interdisciplinary Conference (Figure 1) was held online on 22 May 2026. The organizing committee consisted of experts from seven countries (Colombia, Hungary, Italy, Romania, Slovakia, Serbia, and Türkiye), while participants represented 22 nationalities (Albanian, American, Egyptian, Filipino,

Indian, Iraqi, Jordanian, Kazakh, Kenyan, Hungarian, Malaysian, Nigerian, Pakistani, Palestinian, Romanian, Slovak, South African, Sri Lankan, Serbian, Thai, Tunisian, and Turkish). A total of 217 participants attended the conference, where 151 presentations by 189 authors were delivered in 16 sections (Figure 2).
